To make the comparative form of adjectives (like 'bigger' or 'more expensive') and the superlative form (like 'biggest' or 'most expensive'), first we need to know how many syllables are in the adjective. Adjectives with one syllable Usually if an adjective has only one syllable, we add 'er' to make the comparative form.

Rules of Superlative and Comparative Adjectives | by ...

To form the comparative, we add -er to the end of the adjective. To form the superlative, we add -est to the end of the adjective. * When an adjective ends in the letter E, we just add the -R (for comparatives) or -ST (for superlatives). We do not write two Es together.

Comparatives and Superlatives - English Grammar Notes

We use comparatives and superlatives to compare things and to say which thing is top in a group. Add ' -er ' and ' -est ' for one syllable adjectives. Add ' -ier ' and ' -iest ' for two syllable adjectives which end in ' y ' (and take away the ' y ').
