Before any dredging can be done in a significant water body, a permit must be obtained. Federal Law, under the Clean Water Act of 1976 and Amendments, requires that any person or business that proposes to place a fill or dredged material in the "Waters of the United States" shall first obtain a dredge permit from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

In December 2019, the FY2020 Energy and Water Development appropriations bill was signed into law as part of H.R.1865 and included a new regional dredge demonstration program for the central Gulf Coast.
