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### Effects Of A Discharge Planning

Discharge planning is a widespread process - nurses are frequently involved in planning and coordinating discharge. Discharge planning aims to decrease time spent in hospital, improve patient outcomes and reduce costs. The evidence is not clear over whether discharge planning reduces costs or shifts them from secondary to primary care.

Examining rates of readmission beyond the industry standard of 30 days revealed the sustained effect of discharge planning for hospitalized patients. It appears essential that psychiatric inpatients have postdischarge outpatient appointments in place to minimize relapse.

### Effects of a Structured Discharge Planning Program on ...

Effective discharge planning can help reduce medical errors during transitions of care, which is known to be a time during which patients are particularly vulnerable. Planning for discharge should involve the patient and caregiver and begin as soon as possible during the hospitalization.

The Enhanced Discharge Planning Program (EDPP) was designed to augment rather than replace the inpatient hospital discharge planning practice and build on existing practice. The program began as a pilot to address concerns of hospital discharge planning staff that older adults were especially vulnerable to adverse post-discharge outcomes.

A structured discharge planning tailored to the individual patient probably reduces hospital length of stay and readmission rates for older people admitted to hospital with a medical condition, but the impact of discharge planning on mortality, health outcomes, and cost remains uncertain.

The investigator provided written goals at the bedside, planning brochure with video, and an anticipated discharge date was posted. ### Effects of Discharge Planning and Compliance With ...

Discharge planning is a complex activity, particularly in the context of new services offered outside hospital, like intermediate care, and having a population with more older people, who often have extremely complex care needs.
