Score Card The clock is divided into eighths, beginning with a line through the number 12 and the center of the circle. If the 12 is missing, its position is assumed to be counterclockwise from the 1 at a distance equal to that between the 1 and 2. Any straight edge may be used to divide the clock into eighths.

### Scoring - CLEP - The College Board

To convert a z-score to a T-score, multiple the z-score by 10 and add 50 to your answers (i.e., z-score = .5..5 times 10 equal 5. 5 plus 50 equals 55. Therefore, a z-score of.5 converts to a T-score of 55. As a point of reference, IQs are calculated by multiplying the z-score by 15 (16 on some tests) and then adding 100.

Converting a raw score into a standardised score is relatively easy, provided you can follow the maths; for each given raw score, you divide d by the standard deviation, multiply it by 15 (i.e. one standard deviation), and add this to 100.
