To look at the contents of newer, sdk-style project files in Visual Studio, right-click on the project node in Solution Explorer and select Edit <projectname>. To look at the contents of .NET Framework and other projects of that style, first unload the project (right-click on the project node in Solution Explorer and select Unload Project).

On the start window, choose Create a new project. On the Create a new project page, enter blank solution into the search box, select the Blank Solution template, and then choose Next. Name the solution QuickSolution, and then choose Create. A solution appears in Solution Explorer on the right-hand side of the Visual Studio window.

For Visual Studio 2012, use Collapse and Sync - /vsgallery/291836cc-febe-44ad-86b0-b745485110e7. Adds three buttons to solution explorer. Select current item ; Collapse all ; Collapse all except current item ; Note: Make sure you turn off "Track Active Item in Solution Explorer" (Options -> Projects and solutions)

### Solution Explorer Tools - Visual Studio Marketplace

Choose the Show Folder View command to view the files in Solution Explorer. You can now browse folders and files in the cloned repo, and view and search the code in the Visual Studio code editor, complete with syntax colorization and other features. Run and debug your code. You can debug your code in Visual Studio without a project or solution!

In Visual Studio 2012 you can now use CTRL +; as this is the default keyboard shortcut for the solution explorer search box.

### Easily develop and debug Azure IoT Edge modules with Azure ...

Simply select the node or nodes you would like to recursively collapse and press the button on the Solution Explorer toolbar or use the keyboard shortcutCtl + ALT + Num (-) (Num (-) is the "-" key on the numeric keypad). Select the solution node to recursively collapse all nodes in the Solution Explorer.

### Collapse Selection In Solution Explorer - Visual Studio ...

It seems like a good idea: select a file in the Solution Explorer and it is automatically opened in a special preview tab. Unless it is already open in a tab, in which case that tab is selected. Or if you edit the file, then the preview tab becomes a normal tab. Select a different file and a new preview tab replaces the current one â€” unless the new file is already open.

### How to Disable Previewing the Solution Explorer's Selected ...

Select the image file in the Solution Explorer and right-click. Then, select Generate WebP Files and either the Lossless or Lossy option. Visual Studio Solution Explorer Right click on one of your projects and select the Scope to This menu item. If you haven't noticed this menu item before, don't feel alone. I used Visual Studio for years without 'discovering' it.

### Visual Studio Solution Explorer Tips - Some Neat Features

This step is to avoid that the file from Visual Studio overwrites the one in Sitecore when you publish.In Visual Studio, in the Solution Explorer, right-click the Web.config file in the root of the project, and select Properties. Set the Build Action property to None and the Copy to Output Directory property to Do not copy:

### Set up Sitecore and Visual Studio for development - E-Notes

This is different than navigating your Unity scripts with the normal Visual Studio Solution Explorer, which organizes them into projects and a solution generated by Visual Studio. On the main Visual Studio menu, choose View > Unity Project Explorer. Keyboard shortcut: Alt + Shift + E

### Keep Track of your active files inside Solution Explorer ...

To open the window select View > Solution Explorer. Solution Explorer displays the projects that form your solution, the files and folders in a project as they appear on the physical hard drive, and any assemblies, COM objects or files the project references.
